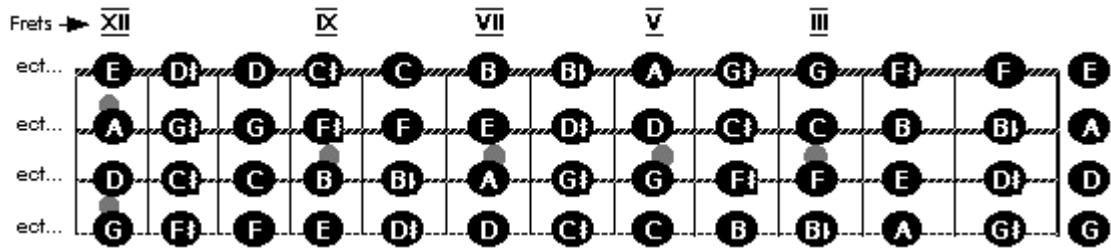


1 FINDING THE NOTES

Here's where you can find your notes on your fretboard.

It's from the lowest E (open E-string) to the 3rd octave G

(12th fret on the G-string). Look out for enharmonic defaults.



Enharmonic defaults. This means that the flat and the sharp notes are mixed up within a key. Observe that the notes may sound alike even though they are written different.

F# = Gb.....(F sharp = G flat)
 G# = Ab.....(G sharp = A flat)
 Bb = A#.....(B flat = A sharp)
 C# = Db.....(C sharp = D flat)
 D# = Eb.....(D sharp = E flat)

Here are more enharmonic defaults...

B# = C.....(B sharp = C perfect)
 Cb = B.....(C flat = B perfect)
 Fb = E.....(F flat = E perfect)
 E# = F.....(E sharp = F perfect)
